Castle Pines Metropolitan District (CPMD)

Homeowner Water Efficiency Rebate Program

The Castle Pines Metropolitan District (CPMD) has initiated a robust, data driven water efficiency program to provide residences of the Village at Castle Pines (Village) the confidence in the security and sustainability of our water future (Vision 2025). This plan was formally adopted by the Board of CPMD on February 4th, 2021. An integral part of the Vision 2025 program is to reduce the Village consumption of water for outdoor irrigation in a thoughtful manner while retaining the beauty of the Village and quality of life for its residents. As part of the water efficiency program CPMD has identified a qualified irrigation management and smart controller experts (Irrigation Analysis) that is prepared to conduct irrigation system audits for each of the custom homes to clearly identify steps needed to reduce water usage while maintaining current landscaping. Information regarding the irrigation management and smart controller experts is also provided (see H2).

To help offset the upfront costs of bringing on the irrigation management and smart controller experts, CPMD is offering a rebate program for custom homeowners. The following contains additional information on this program as well as how you can qualify.

- CPMD custom homes will be eligible for financial incentives based on their commitment to implement the recommended improvements and manage their irrigation systems to achieve efficiency goals for outdoor irrigation.
- The incentive dollars can be used by the enrolled custom homes to offset the cost of water efficiency expenditures.
- The district will cover the expense for an irrigation system audit of the custom homes.
- Rebate Program (Maximum Rebate of 50% of Total Project Costs not to exceed \$700 per home):
 - a. Eligible expenditures include, but are not limited to:
 - i. Installation of Weather-Based EPA Water Sense Approved Controllers
 - ii. High-Efficiency Spray Nozzles
 - iii. Replacement or addition of PRS Check-Valved Heads (Spray or Rotor)
 - iv. Landscape modification designed to reduce Site Water Requirements
 - v. Other initiatives undertaken to specifically reduce outdoor water consumption

Custom homeowners are eligible to receive a rebate on implemented water efficiency efforts as previously described. To apply for the rebate program, custom homeowners must fill out and return the CPMD Custom Homeowner Water Conservation Rebate Request Form (H1).
